2.1 Purpose of the Annual Development Plan

The plan ensures effective resource allocation and sustainable development outcomes for Bungoma County. The ADP is prepared in accordance with: The Constitution of Kenya, 2010; County Governments Act, 2012; Public Finance Management Act, 2012; Urban Areas and Cities Act, 2011.

2.2 Rationale for Public Participation

Public participation is a constitutional requirement under Article 10 and Article 174(c) of the Constitution of Kenya 2010, and Section 87 of the County Governments Act, 2012. Beyond legal compliance, public participation ensures community priorities are reflected in the county development agenda, promotes ownership and sustainability of development projects, and strengthens democratic governance by giving marginalized groups a voice in development decisions.

2.3 Utilization of Public Participation Input in ADP FY 2026/2027

The public input collected will be utilized across three critical phases of the ADP cycle. During the **development phase**, community proposals will inform priority setting, guide resource allocation, and ensure projects are responsive to local needs while integrating cross-cutting issues. During the **implementation phase**, public participation will generate community ownership, establish monitoring frameworks, create feedback mechanisms, and identify local resources to support project delivery and sustainability.
