4	Municipal Board and alignment of programs in the CBD.	Progressive.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The Board should enact basic rules and regulations for effective operations. - Do constant vigil and monitoring through enforcement. -Engage frequently and constructively with relevant stakeholders on matters town planning.

5	General town planning	-Not done.	-Do a town market survey for documentation. - Do market zoning and operationalize business activities in an orderly manner. -Designate special places for parking slots for different transport means i.e. matatus, tax, bodaboda, lories and pickups. -Invest in one stop shopping like general shops markets, malls and supermarkets, food stalls, clothing and other business merchandise. -Can allow metal goods containers installed for market zones in strategic planning. -Create more and spacious open air market spaces within the Municipality. -Plan for gardening and create resting places for people/visitors. -Engage professionals for good planning of the town.

- The Municipal Board to effectively carry out proper market survey and town planning.
- The Board should partner with willing stakeholders in gardening and routine management of the CBD.
- Engage a suitable plan to restructure and effectively address the challenges of street families' i.e by employing the PULL and PUSH strategy or establish rehabilitation centers.
- Proper laws, regulations and other guidelines to be created/enforced by the Board.
- Proper planning of the town dictates that the Municipal Board of Bungoma should ensure constructive engagement with stakeholders.
- Establish a focal point/desk champion in the Municipality for effective monitoring and feedback responsiveness.
